

**I GOT VACCINATED, SO I DON'T HAVE TO WEAR A MASK, RIGHT?**

Nope, not necessarily. County Health Officers and individual businesses can be more strict than the state guidance, but not less. Same with your employer. Unvaccinated individuals must wear a mask in public indoor spaces with very few exceptions. Your boss is required to demonstrate proof of compliance with masking and vaccination status verification.

**CAN MY BOSS REQUIRE ME TO MASK EVEN THOUGH I'M FULLY VACCINATED?**

Yep. Your employer and the Health Officer can require indoor masking even if you're fully vaccinated in order to reduce risk transmission to and from of others.

**I THOUGHT GETTING VACCINATED MEANT I WOULDN'T GET COVID-19, WHAT GIVES?**

We're still learning about the virus and vaccination effects. Vaccination greatly reduces the likelihood of getting and transmitting the virus but we may need to continue with masking and distancing while we are leaning more about keeping everyone safe.

**CAN I BE REQUIRED TO GET THE VACCINE**

Yep. An employer may require employees to be vaccinated as a condition of employment.

**MY HEALTH INFORMATION IS MY BUSINESS. WHAT IF I DON'T WANT TO SHARE MY VACCINATION STATUS WITH MY EMPLOYER?**

If you do not verify vaccination status you will be required to wear a mask.

**MY COWORKER TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19. NOW WHAT?**

If you are vaccinated and were exposed to a COVID-19 positive co-worker you do not need to quarantine or get tested UNLESS you have any symptoms. If you have symptoms after exposure you should isolate away from others and get tested.

If you are unvaccinated you need to quarantine at home, away from others for 10 days (14 is the safest) and get tested right away if you experience any symptoms.

**Verifying Worker Vaccination Status**

Employers must be able to show the process used to verify employee vaccination status. However, they do not need to keep an actual copy of the employee's vaccination records.
