

RESERVATION POLICY

CLALLAM COUNTY PARKS, FAIR, & FACILITIES DEPARTMENT

1. Half of all campsites at Salt Creek and Dungeness Recreation Areas can be reserved in advance of the desired camping date. The remaining campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. All individual campsite reservations must be made online. Reservation cancellations can be made online at www.clallamcountywa.gov/parks. Modification requests for an existing reservation must be done via email to Web_ParksReservations@clallamcountywa.gov .
3. Reservations for the Dungeness Group Area will continue to be made through the park. Contact the Park Manager directly to reserve this facility.

4. All reservations must be made at least seven (7) days prior to the desired camping date. Reservations can be made only for the current calendar year, commencing January 1 for reservations February 1 through October 31.
5. Full payment is required at the time the reservation is made. All reservations must be paid with a credit/debit card.
6. Each reservation will be charged a \$15 non-refundable reservation fee.
7. The 2024 camping fee schedule:

** All applicable state and local taxes are included in the camping fee. **

8. The camping fee includes only one (1) vehicle or self-contained recreational vehicle. Only one (1) self-contained recreational vehicle is allowed per site.
9. An additional vehicle must be registered, and an additional fee paid per night, per vehicle upon arrival at the park. RVs, boats, trailers, extra vehicles, etc. must be parked and fit on the campsite parking space. The vehicles shall not intrude into vegetation, the camping area, the campground roads, or parked beyond the parking curb.
10. The ADA accessible campsites are designated for use by patrons displaying the state-issued license plate or blue and white disability placard.
11. Persons under eighteen (18) years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to camp overnight.
12. There is a maximum of six (6) people allowed per campsite.
13. Maximum stay is limited to fourteen (14) consecutive nights.
14. Check-out time is 12:00 noon. There is no specific check-in time.
15. **Call the park if your arrival at the campsite is expected to be delayed beyond the check-out time (12:00 noon) of the day after the reserved arrival date. Otherwise your reservation will be canceled as a no-show.**
16. **PLEASE HAVE YOUR RESERVATION PERMIT WITH YOU WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE PARK FOR YOUR CAMPING VISIT.**
