

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### CLALLAM COUNTY PARKS, FAIR, AND FACILITIES DEPARTMENT

We recommend that you read the rules and regulations before making a reservation or visiting the park. Each park system operates under different rules and it's best to be acquainted with them beforehand.

I have read and agree to follow the rules and regulations as set forth by the Clallam County Parks, Fair, and Facilities Department. I will also notify all individuals in my party of the same rules and regulations.

The following policies apply to Dungeness and Salt Creek Recreation Areas:

1. **No alcoholic beverages or marijuana allowed in the park per State laws, RCW 66.44.100 and RCW.69.50.445.** Non-compliance may lead to a citation, eviction, and/or not being allowed to return in the future.
2. Pets must remain on a leash, no longer than eight (8) feet, at all times. Pet handlers must remove and properly dispose of all waste from pets. (C.C.C. 23.03.070)
3. No fireworks are allowed in the park.(C.C.C. 23.03.080)
4. Hunting or the use of firearms, bow and arrow, air or gas weapon, or other projectile devices capable of injuring or killing any person or animal or damaging or destroying any park property is prohibited. (C.C.C. 23.03.090)
5. Persons under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to camp overnight. (C.C.C. 23.03.040)
6. To show occupancy, a vehicle or tent must remain in the site at all times. If you plan to leave the campsite during your reservation period, make certain the campsite appears occupied. If the campsite looks empty, you may lose it.
7. Wood fires are permitted within the fire ring only. No fire shall be left unattended nor allowed to extend beyond the capacity of the fire ring. NO BEACH FIRES. (C.C.C. 23.03.100)
8. Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m.; 9:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m. for generators. Noise shall not emit past the assigned campsite. (C.C.C. 23.03.030)
9. Do not place grills or other hot appliances on picnic tables, as they can damage the tables.
10. Each campground has an entrance gate closing at dusk. During the summer months, the gate opens at 7:00 a.m. and closes at 10:00 p.m. Registered campers leaving the Park should plan to return before the posted gate hours. Campers arriving after the gate has closed will not be allowed to drive to their site. They must park outside the gate and walk to their site. No overnight camping is allowed in the parking areas. Individuals arriving after the gate has closed will be able to drive into their campsite when the gate opens at 7:00 a.m.
11. All visitors not camping overnight must leave the park before the gate closes. Gate hours are posted at the entrance.
12. The ADA accessible campsites are designated for use by patrons displaying the state issued license plate or blue and white disability placard.
13. It shall be within the authority of the Park Manager, or their representative, to remove from the Park any or all members of a group whose behavior, at any time, conflicts with County or State laws, becomes detrimental to the health and safety of the group or other Park users, or becomes so unruly as to affect the reasonable enjoyment of the Park by other users.
