

Clallam County Mental Health Court Statistics

83 Defendants have been referred


39 participants have entered a contract.

- 18% have only a Serious Mental Health Illness
- 82% have both – Serious Mental Illness and Substance Use Disorder (Co-occurring).

18 current participants

11 participants have graduated

- 9% recidivism rate of nonviolent offenses (1 new charge)
- 0% recidivism rate of violent offenses.
- 88 combined charges upon entry of Mental Health Court



Per the Washington State Institute for Public policy, the chance the program will produce benefits greater than the cost is 92%.
